HiSource Program Description

HiSource organizes HDS documentation into product related catalogs called bookshelves. HiSource allows a specific item or document to be selected from the active bookshelf to be viewed. Upon selection of the item, HiSource calls the associated viewer.

A bookshelf is composed of all the books (documents) associated with a product line or other designated discriminator. The bookshelf configuration identifies the name and description of the books. If multiple bookshelves are defined or installed within HiSource an open bookshelf function (Ctrl+B) allows switching from the currently selected or active bookshelf.

To open a book either select the book by clicking once and using the Ctrl+O key combination, or simply double-click the book. The book is then read and displayed by the appropriate viewer.

Adobe Acrobat Reader[™] is included on the CD. It will automatically be used if the user does not already have Reader installed.

See the HiSource Installation and Operation Notes in the HiSource Bookshelf for more information.

Why register?

Registering creates a subscription so that subsequent CDs will be shipped directly to you.

Registering allows an email notification of updated documents available, and activates the Update Manager allowing you to update directly through HiSource with an internet connection.

Registration is simple. Use the Options-Registration function to fill in the information.

Send via email the HiSource.RIF file located in the HiSource\notes directory.
