- ___ 1. For installing a drive sled, refer to the procedure "**Installing a Drive Sled**" in **Chapter 2** of the *IBM TotalStorage Ultrium Scalable Tape Library 3583 Setup and Operator Guide*.
- ___ 2. Ensure that you are running the latest levels of firmware on the library, drive and RMU (if installed). To determine the highest level available, visit the web at <http://www.ibm.com/storage/1to>

Note: Be sure you select the Ultrium 2 drive code.

- Select the **Technical Support** link and check against the firmware level on the library.
- Under **Downloads and Utilities**, select **IBM Ultrium Firmware**.

If the firmware update is required, follow the "**Updating Firmware**" procedure in **Chapter 4** of the *IBM TotalStorage Ultrium Scalable Tape Library 3583 Setup and Operator Guide*.

11.0 Test Procedures

- ___ 1. Power on the Library.
- ___ 2. Perform a drive diagnostic test.
 - ___ a. From the **Main Menu** (initial screen), select **More**.
 - ___ b. Select **Service**
 - ___ c. Select **Drives**.
 - ___ d. To run diagnostics on the selected drive, select **OK**.

Note: To run the diagnostic on a different drive, press the button below the **Change Drive** softkey until the number of the drive that you want displays. Press the button below the **OK** softkey.

- ___ e. Select **Diags**.
- ___ f. Press the button below the **Change** softkey until the **FAST Read/Write** diagnostic displays.

Attention: Insert only a scratch data cartridge for this procedure. Data on the cartridge will be overwritten.
- ___ g. Press the button below the **OK** softkey.
- ___ h. The library begins the diagnostic. When the test is complete, the library displays the message **Requested command is now complete**.
- ___ 3. Attach the cables to the library. Refer to the "**Attaching Cables**" procedure in **Chapter 2** of the *IBM TotalStorage Ultrium Scalable Tape Library 3583 Setup and Operator Guide*
