The Nokia Extratalk II / II+ and extension outdoor cabinets are used in conjunction with the Nokia Citytalk DE 34 / DF 34 Outdoor Base Station (BTS) installation.

The Extratalk II / II+ and extension outdoor cabinets provide battery backup for the BTS installation and are used for the housing and supporting of co-sited telecommunications equipment.
