

ELECTRON TUBES METHOD OF DISPOSAL

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the recommended procedure for disposal of electron tubes in central offices. The material presented agrees with Company safety practices.

1.02 It is issued to provide information previously covered in Section 024-722-910PT, which is canceled.

1.03 This section applies to all electron tubes for which there is no credit allowance and are being junked due to their being:

- (1) Defective and not meeting requirements, and
- (2) Considered surplus with no further requirement for any such new or reusable tubes.

2. DISPOSAL

2.01 Return electron tubes to the Western Electric Co. (WECO) for disposal. Pack tubes in original packaging or other suitable container for shipping.

2.02 *Do not destroy or mutilate glass envelopes or base pins of electron tubes.*

2.03 Cathode-ray, cold cathode, and fluorescent tubes should be disposed of in accordance with standard instructions described in:
