KS-19833, L1 PICTURE MONITOR

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section refers to the KS-19833, L1 Television Picture Monitor manufactured by the Harrison Division of the Hewlett-Packard Company.

1.02 The installation, operation, maintenance, and circuit description of this equipment are included in the Operating and Service Manual issued by the manufacturer. 2. DESCRIPTION

2.01 The KS-19833, L1 Picture Monitor is a 17-inch (nominal diagonal measurement) monitor intended for general use in monitoring and maintaining television facilities. All components, with the exception of the picture tube, are solid state. With the external case in place, the monitor is 17-3/8 inches wide, 15-23/32 inches high, 20-1/2 inches deep, and weighs 62 pounds. It may be used portably or mounted in a standard 19-inch rack. The input signal can be from 0.25 V to 2.0 V PP, either 75-ohm unbalanced or 124-ohm balanced. Power consumption is 75 watts at 115 V, 50 to 60 Hz.
