1. GENERAL

1.1 This section provides general information for Automatic Line Preference features to Electronic Telephone users. Individual test sections will be provided for each type of line preference.

1.2 Line Preference features may be divided into originating and terminating groups. Each individual station must have only one feature from the originating group and may or may not have one feature from the terminating group. Terminating preference features take precedence over originating preferences.

1.3 Originating Feature Group consists of:

IDLE LINE PREFERENCE
LAST LINE PREFERENCE
NO LINE PREFERENCE
PRIME LINE PREFERENCE

1.31 Each individual Electronic Telephone set must be assigned one of the originating line preference features.

1.4 Terminating Feature Group consists of:

INCOMING CALL PREFERENCE
RINGING LINE PREFERENCE

1.41 Each individual Electronic Telephone set may or may not have a terminating feature assigned. If none is assigned no terminating preference is provided.

2. RECORDS

2.1 Form SD-97-1313 is required for recording the results of each test.

3. TEST EQUIPMENT AND DOCUMENTATION

3.2 Documentation

3.21 Each originating and terminating line preference feature will be verified once from an Electronic Telephone set. Careful selection of circuits to be used for test will reduce the amount of connecting and disconnecting required. Picking a circuit with both originating and terminating features is an example.

3.22 Use the Customer Order Document to obtain the following:

3.221 Select a circuit to be used as test for each type of line preference assigned in DCTS Station Set Assignments. When selecting a circuit for Idle Line Preference pick one with a minimum number of station lines and note a circuit to pick up each line on circuit used for test.

3.23 Test each preference feature provided once from an Electronic Telephone set. Select and perform test sections as follows:

<u>Section</u>	<u>Title</u>
5161	Idle Line Preference
5162	Last Line Preference
5163	No Line Preference
5164	Prime Line Preference
5165	Incoming Call Preference
5166	Ringin g Line Preference

3.24 Test sections may be performed in any order. If one circuit is being used to test both originating and terminating preference feature run both tests before disconnecting telephone sets.
