

TP180076 AND TP181310 "T" LEVER

APPARATUS AFFECTED: 33A-1 to 33A-5, 33C-1 to 33C-5, 33D-1 to 33D-5, and 33F-1 to 33F-5 Teletypewriter-Sets.

OBJECT: To eliminate possible locking of the keyboard if the control or shift keylevers are only partially depressed and prevent possible dislodgment of the break contact wires during keyboard operation.

CHANGE: The TP180076 "T" lever associated with the No. 5 contact wires has been modified by

1. lengthening the center extension member of the 3 extensions that guide the contact wires from approximately 53/64 inch to approximately 57/64 inch.
2. adding a 1/16-inch diameter by 5/64-inch long projection at a right angle to the tip of the lengthened center extension.

A TP181310 "T" lever replaces the old style TP180076 "T" lever associated with the shift code bar and control tie bar.

The TP180076 "T" lever is shown in Bulletin 1184B, page 4-4, change 3. (See Figure 1.)

IDENTIFICATION: The 3 extensions on the old style TP180076 "T" lever are identical. The center extension on the new style TP180076 "T" lever is longer and has a projection.

New style TP181310 "T" levers resemble new style TP180076 "T" levers but the lower blocking extension below the code bar support bearing post section has been omitted.

INTERCHANGEABILITY: New style TP181310 "T" levers and old style TP180076 "T" levers are interchangeable.

New and old style TP180076 "T" levers are interchangeable.

CLASSIFICATION FOR APPARATUS FURNISHED BY TELETYPE: This change shall be incorporated as soon as manufacturing conditions permit. This is expected to be about August, 1964.

W.E.CO. STOCK OF OLD STYLE PARTS: Shall not be furnished after new style parts become available.

APPLICATION TO APPARATUS IN THE FIELD: Old style parts giving satisfactory service need not be replaced.

APPLICATION AT W.E.CO. DIST. HOUSE REPAIR SHOPS: All units shall be equipped with new style parts as soon as new style parts become available.


