2.1 When any test result specifies that either 60 and/or 120 IPM Flash is to be verified, the corresponding 60 and/or 120 IPM Tone is to be verified.

3. Supplementary Tests

3.1 Incoming Trunks

3.11 Fusing

3.111 Using a test receiver or volt-ohmmeter, check each fuse post for absence of battery and ground.

3.112 Refer to circuit drawings and install fuses of correct type and capacity one at a time. Check unfused circuits for crosses at fuse panel. Check that each fuse is associated with correct circuit by testing for battery at one point in the circuit.

3.12 Sleeve Resistance

NOTE: Test does not apply to SD-25329-01.

3.121 Using voltohmmeter, measure resistance between ground and S lead punching at horizontal T.S. with D relay operated.

3.122 Meter should indicate 9 to 12.5 ohms.

3.123 When testing circuits SD-25432-01 and SD-25436-01, operate relay B instead of relay D.

3.21 Resistance Measurements

3.211 Check value of following resistors using Wheatstone Bridge, ITE-1883 as described in Handbook 50, Section 2.
