RESCUE OF EMPLOYEE FROM POLE

NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum supplements Section G10.210 with instructions for the use of the pole top resuscitation method of treating suffocation resulting from electrical shock sustained by an employee while working aloft.

1. GENERAL

1.02 In most cases where normal breathing has stopped due to electric shock sustained while working aloft, the pole top method of resuscitation as outlined in Addendum G10.207.1 will permit starting artificial respiration with the least possible delay.
