

## RAILROAD CROSSINGS

### GENERAL

#### NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum supplements G10.310.1 and has been reissued to clarify the definition of street railway tracks.

The cross-reference "See Addendum" should be written in Section G10.310.1 at Paragraph 2.03 which is replaced herein, and at Paragraph 7.02.

#### 2. DEFINITIONS

##### 2.03 Street Railway Tracks

The following shall be classified as Street Railway Tracks, and the crossing over them shall be constructed in accordance with the instructions given in the Bell System Practices on Pole Lines, Open Wire, Aerial Cable, and Drop and Block Wire Construction as the construction requirements covering railroad crossings are not applicable to these crossings.

- (a) Los Angeles Transit Lines - All tracks, including such sections which are used jointly with the Pacific Electric Railway Company.
- (b) Pacific Electric Railway Company - All tracks that are operated under the following conditions:
  - (1) For local service only.
  - (2) For local and interurban service, where conditions are such that the interurban trains are operated only at reduced speeds comparable to local service.

(3) For interurban service wherever it is definitely known that trains are required to operate at speeds comparable to local service, as for instance where tracks are located on a public street or thoroughfare subjected to vehicular traffic on or along the tracks, or on private rights of way where there are frequent street crossings at intervals of not more than 1000 feet.
