NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum supplements Section G31.110 and Addendum, Issue 1. It has been reissued to delete instructions now covered elsewhere in the Practices.

Paragraph 2.01 and the note in 10.05 are replaced and should be crossed out and marked, "See Addendum." This cross-reference should also be written following Paragraph 12.01 to indicate the inclusion of additional information.

2. LENGTHS AND WEIGHTS OF STANDARD COILS OF WIRE

2.01 Refer to the section on Open Wire - Weights for information about lengths and weights of standard coils of wire.

10. STRINGING WIRES OVER ELECTRIC LIGHT OR POWER WIRES

10.05 Note: The standard Wire Snap shall be used in all rope rigging required for stringing wire.

15. STRINGING SUBSTITUTE 109 HIGH STRENGTH STEEL LINE WIRE

15.01 When stringing substitute 109 High Strength Steel Line Wire, as covered under WR-G31.051, the coils shall be split so that each side of a circuit will consist of wire from the same original coil.
