Abstract

This IL provides industry notification of the introduction of NPA 281 for relief of the 713 NPA

Letter Information (Includes safety liability disclaimer (if applicable), ordering information, originator's signature information)

We have been advised by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company that substantial telephone number growth in the Houston area necessitates the activation of an additional NPA to serve the area. The new NPA, 281, will go into service at 12:01 AM on March 1, 1995. The 281 NPA will be assigned within the same geographic area where the existing 713 NPA is in effect. This method of relief, called an overlay, will be utilized instead of the traditional NPA split. No number changes will be required.

Southwestern Bell informs us that the 281 NPA will be implemented as a "general purpose" overlay, however, assignments will be made initially to wireless carriers, e.g., pagers, and cellular carriers. Beginning in the first half of 1996, after upgrades have been made to local exchange carriers' operations support systems, number assignments from the 281 NPA code will begin being made to wireline customers.

A permissive dialing period will be established on March 1, 1995 and will last 12 months, until March 1, 1996. During the permissive period the dialing procedures for the 713 and 281 NPAs will be as follows:

- All Home NPA (HNPA) local calls within the 713 NPA may be dialed on a 7 digit basis, i.e., NXX + XXXX, or on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., 713 + NXX + XXXX.
- All HNPA local calls made within the 281 NPA will be dialed on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., 281 + NXX + XXXX (10 digits).
- All HNPA direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + HNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All Foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed local calls will be dialed on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., FNPA + NXX + XXXX. This will include all local calls that are made between the 713 and 281 NPAs.

- All FNPA direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX. (1 + 10 digits).
- All operator assisted calls including local and toll credit card, collect, and third party calls will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits, i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX (0 + 10 digits).

Beginning on March 1, 1996, dialing procedures for the 713 and 281 NPAs will be as follows:


- All HNPA direct dialed local calls will be dialed on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., HNPA + NXX + XXXX (10 digits). This includes local calls made both between and within the 713 and 281 NPAs.
- All HNPA direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + HNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All FNPA direct dialed local calls will be dialed on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., FNPA + NXX + XXXX. This will include all local calls that are made between the 713 and 281 NPAs.
- All FNPA direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All operator assisted calls including local and toll credit card, collect, and third party calls will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits, i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX (0 + 10 digits).

The attached map illustrates the 713 and 281 configuration after the overlay has been implemented. A listing of the city/wire center to be served by the 713/281 is also included.

Test calls to verify routing to the new NPA can be made by calling 281-792-8378. The test number will be in effect from February 1, 1995 until May 1, 1995. A recorded announcement will indicate that the test call has been successfully completed.
