

AUDICHRON TIME ANNOUNCING MACHINE

1. GENERAL. The Audichron Time Announcing Machine, located in the Plant Quarters in Seattle, announces the time of day at 10 second intervals by reproducing sound previously recorded on strips of film. The time booth and time announcement equipment located in the Seattle Traffic Information Bureau will be retained for emergency use.
2. AUDICHRON EQUIPMENT FAILURE. The Audichron equipment is provided with an alarm circuit which will light the supervisory call lamp at the information position. If this lamp and its associated buzzer should operate during the period when the time booth is not occupied, proceed as follows:
 - a. Immediately arrange to assign an operator to the time booth.
 - b. As soon as an operator is ready to make emergency announcements, operate the transfer key on the turret of the time announcement desk. The operation of this key transfers the time announcement system from the Audichron equipment to the time announcement booth and also gives an indicating signal at the Audichron equipment so that a maintenance man will know the booth is occupied.
 - c. During the emergency period, the time operator will make time announcements in accordance with the practice provided in Div. L, Sec. 1.
 - d. When the Plant man informs you that the Audichron machine is again in operation, restore the transfer key and discontinue verbal announcements.
