ADJUSTMENT OF STATION APPARATUS

Handbook Specifications No. 3855, "Adjustment of Substation Apparatus," and Supplement A to these specifications previously adopted for use by The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company and Associated Companies, together with Supplement B, *which is new*, form a part of the handbook specifications for use in The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of Virginia.

Specifications No. 3855 furnish information incidental to the adjustment of Station Apparatus.

Supplement A covers instructions for the adjustment and replacement of relays in selective ringing sets.

Supplement B describes new armature stop springs and an open coil biasing spring for use in station ringers. This supplement also covers instructions for the installation and adjustment of the new armature stop and biasing springs.

The insert (blue sheet) to Specifications No. 3855, dated December 5, 1928, is hereby cancelled and should be removed from the specifications and destroyed.
