STATION WIRING PLANS

Handbook Specifications No. 3859, "Substation Wiring Plans," previously adopted for use by The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company and Associated Companies, together with Supplement B, *which is new*, form a part of the handbook specifications for use in The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of Virginia.

Specifications No. 3859 cover the connection of subscriber sets and associated apparatus on common battery individual lines and private branch exchange extension lines in either manual or dial system districts where keys are required, such installations being considered as station wiring plans.

Supplement B covers new wiring plans and associated apparatus and supersedes Supplement A previously adopted for use by The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company and Associated Companies.

The insert (blue sheet) to Specifications No. 3859, dated March 10, 1925, and Supplement A are hereby canceled and should be removed from the specifications and destroyed.
