




# Dell Inspiron 530 DCMF PCI Slot:Dial up modem Replacement

## INTRODUCTION


The PCI slot can hold many different types of cards, such as a dial up modem, wifi receiver, or bluetooth.

## Step 1 — PCI Slot:Dial up modem





- Unscrew the two large screws in back holding on the side panel. Slide the panel backwards to remove it

## Step 2




- The PCI slots are located at the bottom back of the computer.
- Unscrew the screw to release the metal piece that holds the cards in place.

### Step 3



- Slide the card in the PCI slot up and out, in this case a dial up modem.

### Step 4



- Take the new card and slide it into the slot you just removed the old one out of.
- Remember to replace the metal piece you removed earlier to secure the cards in place.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
