



How to Remove Hard Water Stains from Glass Shower Door

Hard water contains minerals that stick around after the water has washed away. Those minerals can leave stains on shower doors that are impossible to hide. Luckily, there's an easy way to remove these stains and make your shower door sparkling clean.

INTRODUCTION

The hard water stains can easily be removed using common household items: white vinegar, a spray bottle, and a sponge.

TOOLS:

Step 1 — How to Remove Hard Water Stains from Glass Shower Door



- Fill the spray bottle with mixture of water and white vinegar (approx 50/50).

Step 2



- Spray the solution on to the glass with the bottle.

Step 3




- Wipe the solution on the door with the damp sponge.

Step 4




- Let the solution sit on the door for several minutes.

Step 5



- Keep applying the solution as it dries.
- Keep the door wet for at least 5 minutes.

Step 6



- Rinse the solution off the door with warm water.
- ⓘ If the results are not satisfactory, try adding more vinegar to the solution and go back to step 1.
